Public Health services commissioned by KCC: Smoking Cessation. Information for practices.

Practices are requested to follow the processes documented below to ensure items are only prescribed with behavioral support. The recommendations apply to all strengths and both branded and generic forms unless otherwise specified.

Please note – under the GMS contract, a GP has the right to prescribe any products to meet an identified need. However, the costs of any such prescribing (i.e. under GMS but outside the contracted Public Health services) will remain with practice's prescribing budget and will not be reimbursed to the CCG by Public Health – Kent County Council (PH-KCC).

As of 1st January 2018 varencline (Champix®) is available from stop smoking services under patient group direction (PGD)
